- 1. What are the timings for a hockey game?
  - 3 periods, 20 minutes each
  - No TV time outs
  - Player breaks about 10-15 minutes between periods
  - Ice is flooded before the game starts and after the 2<sup>nd</sup> period
  - Round Robin games may end in a tie no overtime play
  - All games after Round Robin must have a winner overtime play may be required
- 2. What type of accommodation and provisions are provided at the arena?
  - One control room, located ice level beside the blue rink is available for the livestream team
  - Control room can be secured/locked
  - Food and drinks will be available for the livestream team in the VIP room
- 3. Who will provide the on camera and commentator(s)?
  - Identify your ability to provide commentators for regular games and medal games
  - List languages commentators are able to speak
  - Provide separate cost for this activity
- 4. Who will provide Team/Coach/Player interviews?
  - Identify your ability to provide pre-recorded interviews or soundbites for website and insertion into livestream videos
  - Intent to have all Teams participate
  - Provide separate cost for this activity
- 5. Are you capturing Hockey Highlights?
  - Identify your ability to capture/manage hockey highlights of the day (top saves, goals, etc.)
  - Create a montage of daily highlights for the 20<sup>th</sup> NAHC
  - Promote on social media
  - Provide separate cost for this activity
- 6. How are you dealing with Sponsor Content?
  - Identify your ability to reach out to sponsors and create pre-recorded segments for website and insertion into livestream videos
  - Provide separate cost for this activity
- 7. What is the budget?
